Propylene Glycol B.P and

INDICATIONS:

Cattle: Tylosin Injection is indicated for use in the treatment of bovine respiratory complex (shipping fever, pneumonia) usually associated with Pasteurella multocida and Actinomyces pyogenes; foot rot (necrotic pododermatitis) and calf diphtheria caused by Fusobacterium necorphorum and metritis caused by Actinomyces pyogenes.

Sheep: Pneumonia, arthritis, contagious and acute agalaxia due Mycoplasma agalactie, mastitis.

Goat: Contagious pleuropneumonia due Mycoplasma mycoeides.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS:

Not to be used in animals known to be hypersensitive to the active ingredient.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION:

Cattle:

Inject 5-10 mg/kg of body weight daily intramuscularly. Do not inject more than 10 ml per injection site.

Sheep and Goats:

Inject 10 mg/kg of body weight daily intramuscularly. Do not inject more than 5 ml per injection site.

WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

Cattle:

Edible tissue: 7 days : 72 hours Milk

Sheep, Goats:

Edible tissue: 7 days Milk : 48 hours

STORAGE:

Store at a temperature not exceeding 30°C.

Protect from light.
